- **Scope**: The test will be conducted on the UnProtected Victims website. This test will cover the recent prototype dev of the website as of April 23, 2021. Test will consist of: navigation and content, flexibility on different devices, donate features/links(key), sending emails/getting in touch, checking out events and latest news information, Using the admin to login and adding new events.
- **Purposes**: Purpose of this test is to make sure that it's easy for users to contact unprotected victims for help. Some concerns are we want to make sure that the website is easily navigational on any device. As well as making it easy for people to either sign up for volunteer or donate. Lastly our big concern is we want to make sure that Mrs. Melissa is able to add new events if she needs to.
